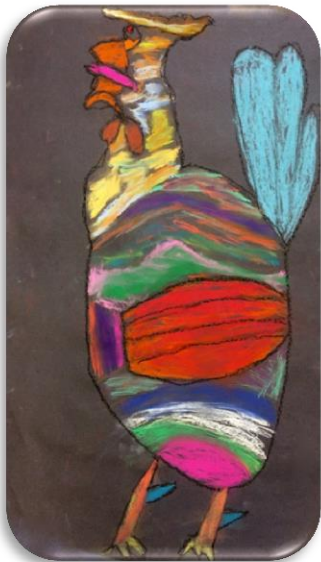

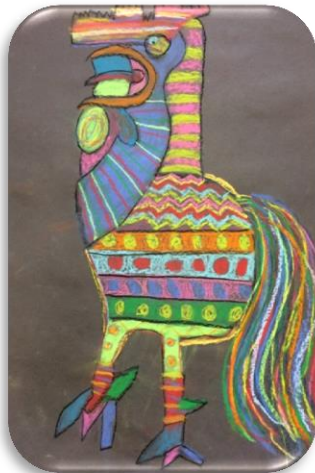

Form J6Y has been looking at Picasso's Le Coq drawings and has made their own fantastic cockerels.



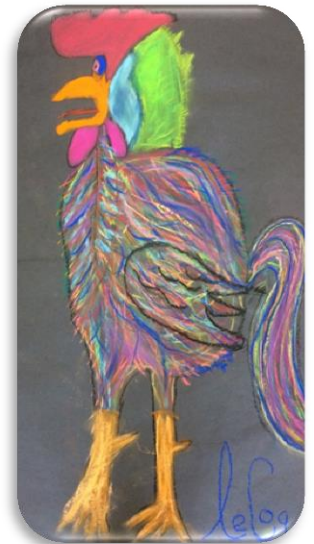

Union Chain Bridge Information

The Union Chain Bridge is scheduled for closure on 26th June - 21st July. The second closure is scheduled for 11th September - 20th November. The reason given for the closure seems to be "for investigatory works to the bridge including ground investigations, strain monitoring and non-destructive testing. Pedestrian access is being maintained across the bridge but no vehicular access is permitted across the structure during the works.
