## LTSDA Chairmans Report 2022

I would like to start off this report, as always with a big thank you to all the members and helpers for supporting with all the fundraising events during this last academic year.

The first event we had in the LTSDA calendar was the Christmas fair. Due to Covid we had to cancel the previous two years. We were very excited to invite back some previous stall holders and also some new ones.
