INDUSTRIAL SECTION

- 1. Victoria sponge, jam filled, not iced
- 2. Lemon drizzle cake, made in a loaf tin
- 3. Four fruit scones
- 4. Four rock buns
- 5. Four decorated cupcakes, judged on decoration only
- **6.** Four pieces of unbaked tray bake
- 7. Four pieces of baked tray bake
- **8.** A loaf of brown or white bread, any shape, NOT made in a bread maker
- 9. Baking disaster can be entered on the day!
- 10. A jar of homemade marmalade
- 11. A jar of homemade jam, any sort
- **12.** A jar of homemade chutney

Tips for Novice Exhibitors

Jams and Marmalade. The judge will be looking for a lovely full jar. All jars should be sealed with a wax disc and cellophane. There should be a clear label on each jar stating the date made and the variety.

Chutney improves greatly with age and so ideally should be shown a few months after making. Again, sealing and labelling are important.

When staging your item use a sealed, small brown envelope or buff coloured luggage label to write your name, class and age. If you are not a pupil just state your name and relationship to the school e.g., parent, grandma, bus driver etc. etc. This should be placed under the item, face down.

13. Beginner's baking- Triple Choc Muffins, using the recipe, four muffins to be staged

Triple Chocolate Muffins

Ingredients:

270g SR Flour 2TBSP Cocoa Powder 250mls Milk

150g Choc Chips 110g Caster Sugar 1 Large Egg

110g Sunflower Oil 1 TSP Vanilla Extract

- i. Preheat oven to 180c or equivalent.
- ii. Grease muffin tin or prepare cake cases.
- iii. Weigh out flour, cocoa powder and choc chips into a small bowl.
- iv. In a larger bowl, whisk together oil, sugar, egg, milk and vanilla until smooth.
- v. Mix dry ingredients into the wet ones and stir to combine, only stir until there is no bare flour visible, lumps don't matter!
- vi. Divide equally between 12 cases.
- vii. Place in oven and bake for 20-25mins or until the tops are springy.
- viii. You shouldn't leave a dent when pushing down.

- **28.** Design a book cover, J3 J6 to design a cover for Horrible Histories
- **29.** Design a book cover, F1 ~ F3 to design a cover for The Hunger Games.
- **30.** Design a book cover, F4 ~ U6 to design a cover for a Percy Jackson book.
