Initial Charges and Deposits

Registration Fee: £100
 Payable on application (non-refundable) £350 (No-UK)

Acceptance Deposit: £350 (Day pupils)
 £500 (UK Boarding)
 £10,600 Full Terms Fees (Non-UK Boarding)

These are payable when the pupil is offered a place. The acceptance deposit is repaid when the pupil leaves the School.

Boarding Fees

The above fees include all accommodation, meal and laundry costs and weekend trips.

Excluded:

- Medical costs not covered by the National Health Service.
- Spending money, Uniform
- Transport, such as the cost of trips to the airport at the start and end of each term.
- Tuition in English as a Second Language, for pupils who have been assessed as needing support. The charge for this is £425 a term. This is for one weekly lesson. Multiple lessons may be required at an additional cost.

Allowances, Scholarships and Bursaries

Sibling Allowances: Where a family has more than one child attending the School, there is a concession of 5% off the fees of the second child and 40% off the third and subsequent children.

Scholarships: Are available, based on academic examinations, and for pupils who show outstanding ability in music, art or sport. Scholarship examinations are held at the end of November for the following September.

Bursaries (means tested): Limited support may be available to assist with day fees. More details are available from the Bursar.

Other Termly Charges

A half-term's notice is required when any of the following services are no longer required:

School Bus Service:

The School has its own fleet of mini buses and drivers, and contracts its larger bus services to local operators. The service runs for the benefit of parents on a non-profit making basis. Suggestions for new routes should be made to the Bursar at least a term in advance. Up to date information on bus routes can be found on the school website. The service operates at the start and end of each school day, with a termly charge in advance according to the destination.

An excellent range of midday meals is available. A termly charge is made in advance, based on the daily prices shown above. Parents who do not wish their children to take school meals should provide packed lunches each day.

Music Tuition: £20 per half hour lesson

Instrumental music tuition is available for various instruments. Parents will be invoiced by the peripatetic teacher. You will normally be required to provide your own instrument.

Flexi Boarding: £32 per night
 £40 for Saturday night and Sunday activity
 Attending a school event - leaving early morning etc. £15 with a sleeping bag
 Tea and supervision £10
 Representing the School for a sports fixture with an early departure or return after 7pm etc. Free of charge.
